

More US adults have air travel plans now than before the pandemic

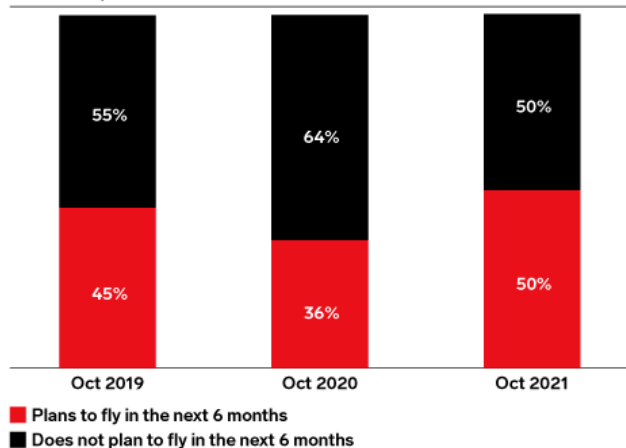

Half of US adults plan to fly in the next six months as of October 2021, up **14 percentage points** from October 2020. Notably, the 2021 figure was also up **5 percentage points** from October 2019, as travelers return to the skies with enthusiasm.
