

How do US adults feel about a cashless society?

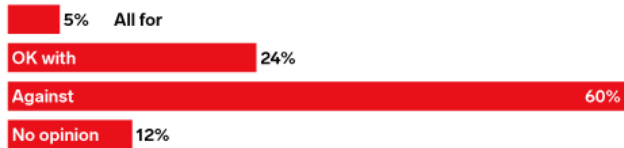

The majority of US adults are against living in a cashless society, with **60%** indicating they'd prefer physical money to stick around. That said, **24%** stated they're OK with such a society, and an additional **5%** said they're all for it, even as moving away from cash means people would need access to digital alternatives to participate.
