


PayPal dominates mobile payments in the US

Article





Key stat: PayPal is the most popular <u>mobile</u> payment app that US adults typically use, with over twice as many users as the next most popular choice, Venmo, according to November 2024 data from YouGov.

Beyond the chart:

- We forecast PayPal transaction payment value to reach \$1.20 trillion in 2025, 61.5% of worldwide PayPal transaction payment value.
- There will be 91.5 million core PayPal users in the US this year, nearly a third (32.0%) of the population.

Use this chart: Marketers can use this chart to align ad placements with the most popular mobile payment apps and consider partnership opportunities to expand their reach.

Methodology: Data is from a December 2024 YouGov analysis as cited in company blog. US adults ages 18+ were surveyed online as part of YouGov Profiles. Results are based on continuously collected data from rolling surveys from November 2023-November 2024, rather than from a single questionnaire.
