

# 1 in 3 US workers would quit their job if health insurance weren't a factor



Many jobs in the US are tied to health insurance, which in turn is tying many workers to their jobs. Among employed adults with health insurance, **33%** would be very or somewhat likely to

leave their job if health insurance were not a factor. This figure jumps to **40%** among those 34 and younger.
