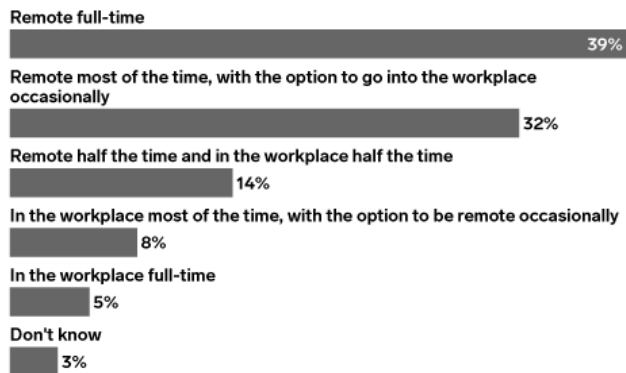

Despite vaccinations giving hope for a return to normalcy, nearly 2 in 5 US remote employees agree that they are never, ever, ever getting back together with their office. Only **5%** of remote employees want to go back into the workplace full-time, which could make for some fairly deserted office spaces. Overall, **7 in 10** work-from-homers say they prefer to stay home—right next to the exercise equipment, make-shift standing desk, designated nap space, and cozy sweatpants.
