

US Adults Want Safer, Cleaner Travel Guidelines Once Air Travel Resumes

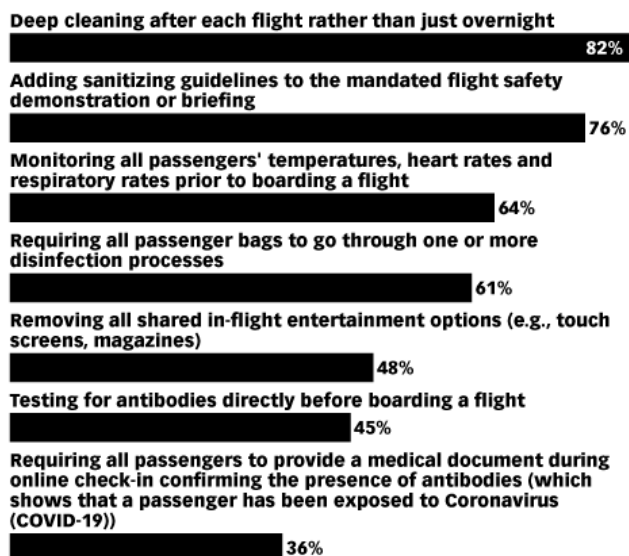

Many US adults are standing behind any potential actions airlines and airports plan to take in response to the pandemic, according to May 2020 data from YouGov.

The largest share of respondents (82%) said they support deep cleaning after each flight rather than airlines just doing so overnight, and slightly fewer (76%) were in support of adding sanitizing guidelines. Monitoring passengers' temperatures, heart rates and respiratory rates before boarding a flight was another measure nearly two-thirds of US adults support.

Airlines may even see an increase in travel insurance post-pandemic. According to the same survey, more than half (57%) of respondents said they would consider buying an insurance policy that would issue full refunds in case they're denied boarding.
