Capital One was the most downloaded US banking app between January and April 2022, with **5.0 million** net new installations. Digital-only contender **Chime** took the No. 2 spot, with **4.7 million**, while **Chase** came in third, with **4.1 million** net new installs.






Beyond the chart: At this rate, the top three are well on their way to beating their total download numbers from last year, contributing to the **4.3**% growth we project for the US mobile phone banking user base in 2022. Still, **37.9**% of US adults will not bank via a mobile phone this year, which presents an opportunity for further growth among digital-only financial institutions. But physical branches remain highly relevant for the **21.1**% of adults who won't use any form of digital banking.
