

# A look at how US healthcare providers use telehealth

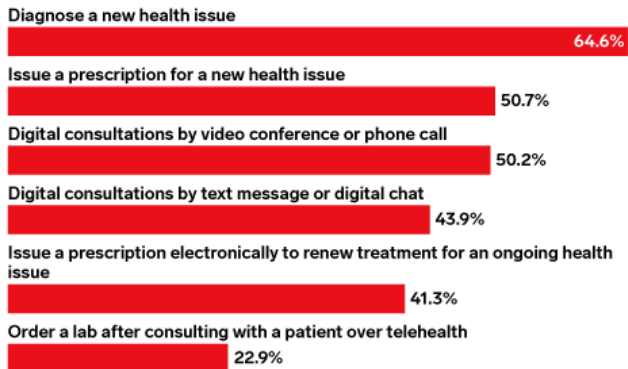
As the COVID-19 pandemic wears on, US healthcare providers are incorporating telehealth into their practice, particularly when treating new concerns. Among those who offer telehealth

services, **64.6%** use the technology to diagnose new issues, while about **50%** each use it to issue new prescriptions and conduct video or phone consultations.
