

The smartphone industry is feeling the squeeze of the semiconductor shortage. This year, **1.41** billion smartphones will be shipped worldwide, less than the annual volume of both 2018 and 2019. The 2021 figure also falls short of previous expectations by **40 million**, as the limited chip supply continues plaguing smartphone-makers and vendors alike.
