

The top 5 issues US consumers are concerned about interfering with their retirement

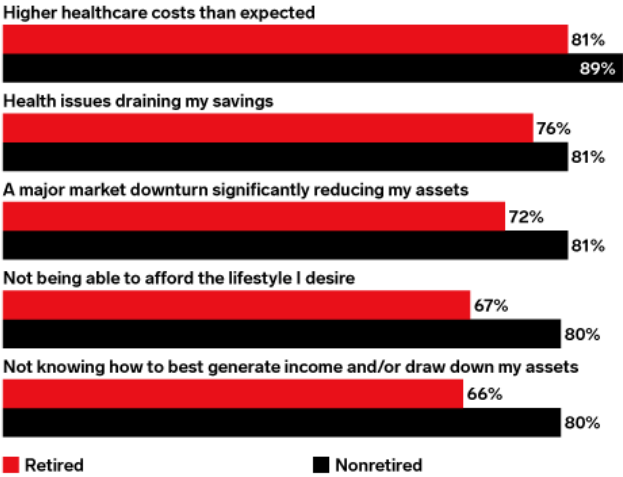

Social security may not have Americans feeling as secure as it once did. Nearly 9 in 10 US adults who are not yet retired view high healthcare costs as potentially probative of retirement, and 8 in 10 people in that same group are concerned health issues will drain their retirement savings.
