

# Boomers have 10 times the household wealth of millennials in the US

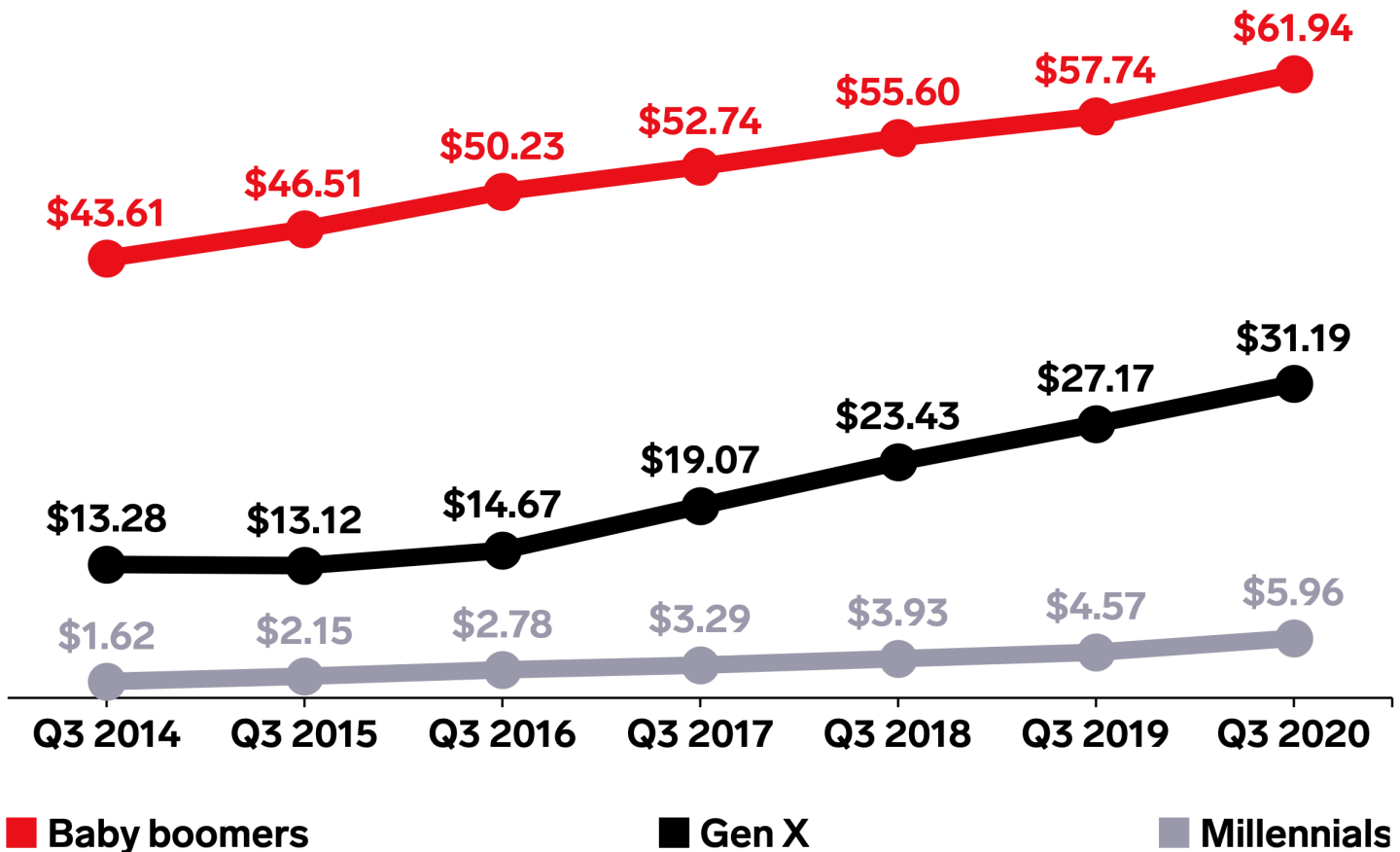

**Boomers had twice the household wealth of Gen X and 10 times that of millennials in the US in Q3 2020.** This disparity is increasing rapidly as well; boomers' household wealth increased by over **\$18 trillion** since 2014, while millennial wealth increased by just **\$4 trillion**.
