Chime rang out a banner year in US downloads



Chime was the most downloaded US mobile banking app in 2021, with **12.8 million** downloads, up **16**% from 2020. Other neobanks had a huge year as well: **Current** posted **67**% growth in downloads, and **Varo** skyrocketed to 10th place with a **529**% increase. That said, traditional banks took the rest of the top five positions.

Beyond the chart: The top half of the list was virtually unchanged from 2020. **Capital One** overtook **Chase** to claim the No. 2 spot, while **Bank of America** and **Wells Fargo** held onto fourth and fifth place, respectively. But as consumers seek lower fees and streamlined technology, interest in digital-only banks will continue to mount, threatening a shake-up among the most popular banking apps in years to come.
